- 3) If your rifle is a HK416 you will need to remove the factory sling swivel loop on the gas block. Use a cutoff wheel to carefully remove the loop as it is hardened steel.
- 4) Remove the cross bolt with the provided 5mm allen wrench.
- 5) Carefully slide the handguard onto the factory barrel nut. Do not force it on. Slide it on until the handguard touches the upper receiver.
- 6) Re-install the cross bolt. To tighten use the 5mm allen wrench or you can use a 10mm socket. Torque the cross bolt to 10ft lb.
